

# Bouncing, Porpoising, Wheelbarrowing, Ground-looping - The ‘Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse’

Closer examination of landings reveal that a great number of the problems are entirely preventable, but often poorly understood. In this seminar you will learn: Why most pilots are approaching at the wrong airspeed without knowing it; Why that old rule of ‘power for airspeed, pitch for’ is making your life miserable; The visual cues that tell you what inputs you need to make; When ‘cross-controlling’ is a good thing;
