

August 2011 Enhancements to www.FAASafety.gov

1. A new portal was added to the Home page for the See and Avoid website. The FAA Safety Team now hosts this site as part of our safety initiative.



2. Two links in the "sign-in" panel, My Courses and My Seminars, were removed. A review showed that very few users took advantage of those links. That information is now more conveniently located in one place under the Courses, Seminars & Activities tab. This sign in area is now dedicated to user information, and links to your Airman profile and your site preferences.



3. The WINGS Timeline has been removed from the Activity History page and is available on your My WINGS page only.
4. The tool tip that is displayed for the WINGS Timeline now includes the specific "slot" it was applied to; i.e., Knowledge 1, Flight 2, etc.
5. For the convenience of those managers who approve SPANS events, the order of presentation on the SPANS review and approval page is now in pure date order. In other words, we ignore the free vs. cost status on this page only.
6. The "Refresh Checklist" feature on the My WINGS page, which was a manual step you had to remember to use when you changed your Airman Profile, is now automated anytime you change and save your Airman Profile.

7. The text on your My WINGS page has been expanded to more fully describe the WINGS Program.

Welcome to your personalized My WINGS Page!

The WINGS – Pilot Proficiency Program is designed to help you build a program of recurrent training consistent with your distinctive flight requirements. To accomplish each Phase of WINGS, you can attend safety seminars, take online courses, and demonstrate flight proficiency. You must earn 6 credits to complete a Phase of WINGS - 3 knowledge activity credits and 3 flight activity credits. To ensure you receive a well-rounded learning experience, only selected activities fulfill certain credit requirements. (You can see more details of the WINGS Program by clicking on the blue banner below.)

Although there are Advanced and Master Levels for pilots wishing to demonstrate a higher level of skill and proficiency, most pilots will be satisfied with accomplishments at the Basic Level. While you may earn additional Phases by completing 3 additional knowledge activities and 3 additional flight activities, the program only requires you to complete a Phase once every 12 calendar months.

Pilots may earn a Phase of WINGS using a seaplane, and get a distinctive Sea WINGS pin for that accomplishment. Be sure to modify your WINGS Profile to show you hold a seaplane rating. The system will confirm that you actually hold a Seaplane rating when you request the Sea WINGS pin.

11. Now that there is a report that CFIs can use to prove to a FSDO that they conducted **WINGS** activities, we needed a way for the CFI to confirm that he or she conducted that activity. We added a required response to the Credit Validation form (For Flight Activities only) so that when instructors validate WINGS credit, they have to indicate whether they conducted the activity. This response will appear on that report for future activities. For past activities, a yes or no box is provided and the CFI has to check one.

Because of your "permission level" on FAASafety.gov, it is possible for you to validate WINGS training credit actually given by another flight instructor. To insure accurate recordkeeping, we ask that you record whether you flew with the pilot and conducted this training (answer "yes") or if you did not fly with this pilot and the training was conducted by someone else (answer "no").

12. Changes have been made to the display of the exam link for all FAASite online courses. The exam link is only available after the Review has been completed. The Review is only available after all the previous chapters have been completed. All chapters will be displayed so you know at a glance (by the different color) which you've completed.

Note: You must view the intro, all chapters, as well as the review, in order to take the course exam.
